In September, a priority will be to re-launch the behaviour policy - switch PRIDE merits to Dojo points (which will be aligned to Pendock PRIDE values). These will be celebrated through house points and shared in assemblies. The key will be consistency and communication between all staff members to ensure that the children have clear boundaries of what is acceptable and not acceptable in school. The behaviour policy has three sections – safety, learning and respect. These will be talked about with the children so they can understand the choices that they make.

77% feel positive


20% disagree. This question will be explored further with parents to find out how we could do better and what type of communication would enable them to be better informed. We will also explore this as a staff.

### Pendock is well led and managed.






### Pendock lets me know how my child is doing.

This will be followed up through the additional questionnaire to parents this term to gauge their ideas/thoughts on how this could be improved. This will also be discussed with staff.


## There is a good range of subjects available to my child at Pendock.

This supports our drive to ensure that the children get a broad and balanced curriculum – all subjects are important and have value in shaping the whole child.


## I would recommend Pendock to another parent.
